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
# Background

- Rise in the number and percentage of International Students
- Concentration in certain majors (Stats, Econ, Bus Admin, Engineering, Applied Math)
- Large proportion of entering freshmen classes
- Rising concern from faculty and staff about impacts of this change in student composition

## Myth Busting

#### Gradation/retention

- Similar 4 year Freshmen graduation rates
- Higher 4 year graduation rates for Int Transfer
- Lower 1<sup>st</sup> year retention and 6 yr graduation rates

#### **Academic Performance**

- Take higher course load (16 versus 15 units)
- No difference in GPA
- No differences in GPA's or grad distributions in Reading and Composition courses





- International students report lower sense of belonging
- Are less satisfied with their social experience
- Are less satisfied with the value of their Berkeley education for the price they are paying
- Report similar level of satisfaction with academic advising









- Shifted the conversation from one of liability to one of equity and responsibility for the student experience
- Set the stage for financial commitments and new/enhanced programs
