

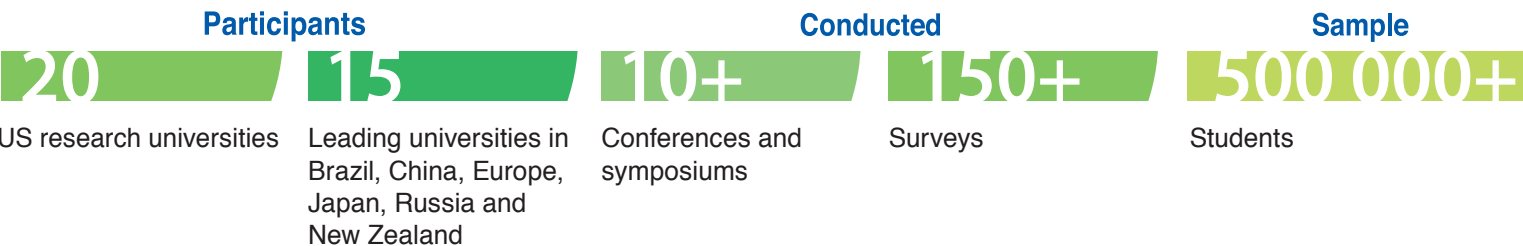
GEOGRAPHY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SERU CONSORTIUM

The university members conduct student surveys applying the same methodology and use the results to improve the educational environment for students.

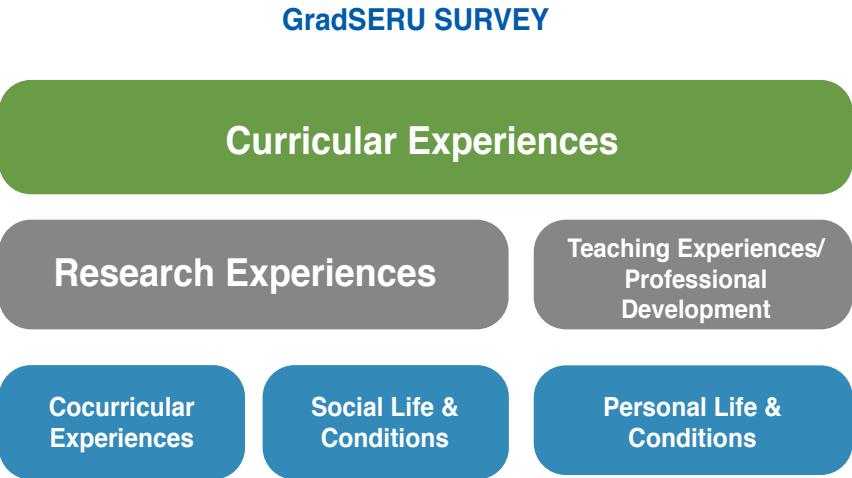
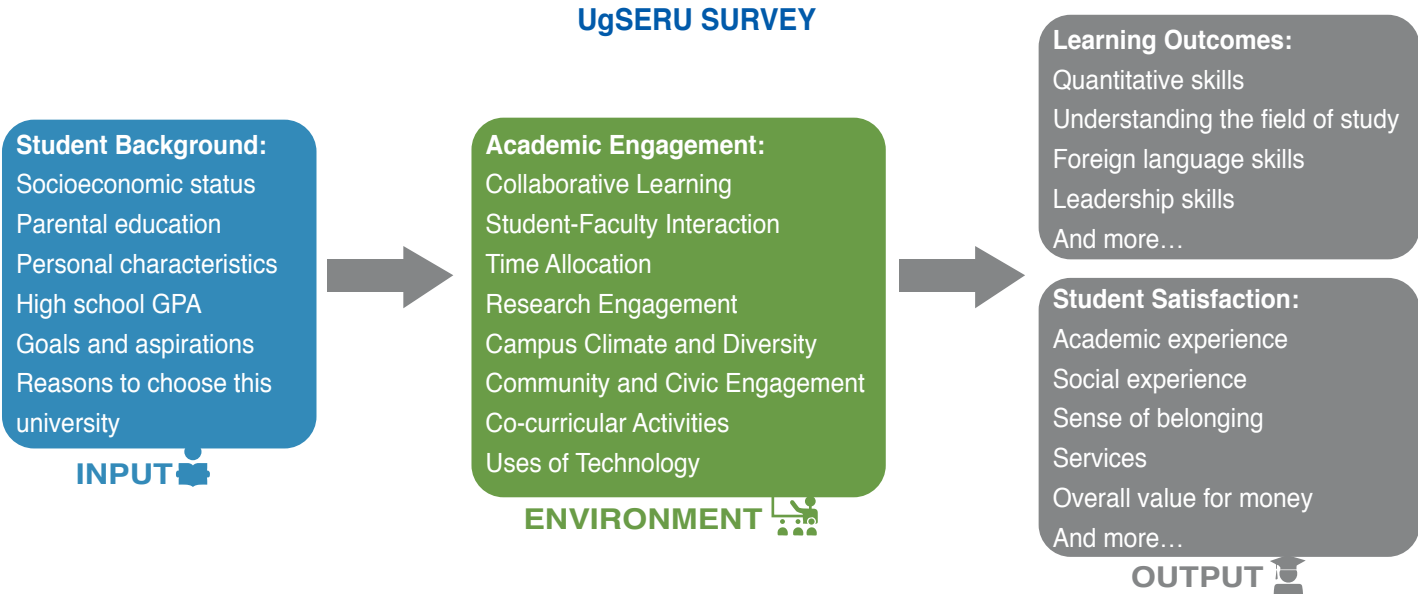

AS PART OF THE PROJECT, MEMBER UNIVERSITIES:

- Conduct online student surveys adapted for a particular country and university.
- Share results, as well as institutional and longitudinal data.
- Exchange best practices for utilizing SERU results, participate in international conferences, symposiums and other projects related to education policy and the development of the academic environment.
- Analyze challenges facing research universities and discuss possible solutions.

SERU DATA USES FOR POLICY AND RESEARCH:

- To analyze validity of admissions criteria for the nine undergraduate campuses.
- To conduct a reform of financial aid program for low-income students.
- To review curriculum to encourage academic engagement outside of the classroom.
- Reassessment of student time and curricular reform – development of Minors Program and out-of-classroom activities.
